Social Members (Waiting List 1-80)

Social members pay ½ of a green fee each time they play and <u>must check in the</u> <u>pro shop</u> before teeing off.

Before June 15th and after September 15th, Social members may play golf anytime on weekdays. They cannot play Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays until 10 AM.

From June 15th through September 15th social members may play weekdays, Monday through Thursday after 10AM and on Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays after 1PM.

A social membership may have 1 guest during their time spot. Social members may play in Birdie Train, fill in Leagues and on the ladies Day. When social members participate in golf leagues they pay a 9-hole rate of 50% of the social green fee.

House Members (Waiting List 81-up)

House members may play golf on payment of the prevailing guest fee and a surcharge of \$100 per year. Contact the club office to be put on a list of house members eligible to play. This list will be forwarded to the pro shop. House members <u>must check</u> in the pro shop before teeing off.

Play is restricted to weekdays and after 2 PM on weekends/holidays before June 15th and after September 15th. House members may be guests of full members for play.

Golf Rules

<u>Guests:</u> The privilege of introducing guests is governed by the following rules. Any member introducing guests shall be responsible for them and for the payment of the prescribed fees and all indebtedness incurred by the guest. **Members must register their guests in the pro shop before teeing off.**

- a. Only full golfing members and social members are permitted to introduce guests.
- b. On Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays full members can bring 1 guest after 11 AM June 15 through September 15. After 1 PM, they may have 3 guest.
- c. Before June 1 and after September 15, Monday through Thursday after 12 PM full members may have 11 guests or less with prior approval of the pro shop.
- d. A social membership can have 1 guest during their time slot.

<u>Golf Carts: Golf</u> Carts must be operated in accordance with the following rules and such others as may be posted from time to time.

- a. No more than two (2) persons shall ride in or use each cart. No children are to ride in the cart when two (2) adults occupy a cart.
- b. Carts are to be kept on fairways and mowed roughs. Under no circumstances are carts to be taken into wooded, ravine, or marsh areas or within thirty (30) feet of the greens or tees. Please observe signs or painted lines on the ground for the purpose of directing carts traffic away from sensitive areas. Carts are

- to be kept on cart paths where provided, otherwise in roughs and then fairways, in that order. Handicapped players are allowed special use of golf carts and are provided a special flag for display on their carts for this purpose.
- c. Carts are not permitted on tees, greens, aprons, or in bunkers.
- d. Before players are to putt, carts must be parked safely to side or back en route to the next tee (but in no event closer than thirty (30) feet from the green) in order to speed up play.

<u>Pull Carts/Motorized Pull Carts:</u> Players must not pull or operate their carts between bunkers and greens or within thirty (30) feet of greens or onto tees.

Golf Attire: Attire on the golf course, driving range, or putting green shall be in good taste and with forethought. For men and boys, collared shirts, tucked in, slacks or Bermuda shorts are minimally acceptable attire. Blue jeans, "cut-offs", tennis shorts, bathing suits, and tennis warm ups and tee shirts are not considered acceptable. Caps are expected to be worn with the bill facing forward. Suitable golf attire for ladies and girls include shirts, golf skirts, slacks, and Bermuda shorts. Blue jeans, "cut-offs", short shorts, tee shirts, tennis shorts, bathing suits tennis warm ups, tank tops and halter tops are not considered suitable. Appropriate golf and tennis attire is required in the clubhouse, café or pro shops. Members are responsible for the attire of their guests.

<u>Divots:</u> Turf cut or displaced by a stroke must be replaced. All footprints in traps must be smoothed or raked. Ball marks on greens must be repaired.

Practice: Practice is restricted to the practice area and the two practice greens. There shall be no chipping or pitching to the putting green, only to the pitching green at the farthest extremity of the practice area. In the interest of preventing unnecessary damage to the practice range, members are requested to note the position of markers to confine their practice shots to the area between such markers. Golf carts (excepting that of the Golf Professional) are prohibited from the practice area.

<u>Cutting In: All</u> golf holes must be played in succession until 10:00AM unless permission to deviate is granted by the Pro. Cutting in is forbidden if players are visible anywhere on the preceding hole. Players have no standing and shall give way forthwith to players in regular order, whether or not such players in regular order give warning or ask to go through.

<u>Tee Times and the York Golf Lottery System:</u> The York Golf Lottery System is a process where all the Memberships have an equal chance to get a preferred tee time. Lottery slips are available in the pro Shop and may be make out at any time for the following Friday, Saturday, Sunday and holidays. You may call the Pro Shop to have your ballot filled out over the phone. **Mark the ballot** either Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Holiday, your desired time, (i.e. 0630, 0700, 0730, etc.) right up to 11:00 AM. **Please**Note: Friday lottery tee times will be drawn up to the 12:40 PM. Mark the slip whether or not you want a later or earlier than your desired tee time if your exact time is not available when your name is drawn, and provide at least 2 names. Then place the ballot

in the lottery box. If you are a twosome or threesome the Pro will try to match-up anyone that is in the lottery or that may be looking for a game on your chosen day. If by chance you get "shutout" and all the tee times are taken by the time your name is drawn, (this should be very rare since we eliminated guests on weekends until after 11:00), you would get first chance at any tee time for the following weekend. Friday Tee times are drawn on Tuesdays after 5 PM. Saturday, Sunday and Holiday tee times are drawn on Wednesdays after 5 PM. You can then stop in at the Pro Shop or call to see when your tee time is posted. All other tee times may be made 2 days in advance by calling the Pro Shop at 363-2683. The lottery system is only used for the crunch of Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Holiday mornings. Note: For the respect and benefit of all club members, if someone in your foursome cancels, notify the Pro Shop within 24 hours so that "the tee time is filled" by another member. Failure to follow this policy may result in possible loss of weekend privileges.

Practice Area Policy:

April 15 – May 15 Grass Tee's **Closed Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday USE MAT"S ONLY**

May 16 – October 15 Unless otherwise posted, grass tee's will be open daily.

October 16 – November 1 Grass tees's open only Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

November on mats only

The range will close at 5 PM Mondays for early Tuesday morning mowing. All practice balls will be removed. You may use your own balls on the chipping and putting greens
