Dear Parents,

Welcome to the York Golf and Tennis Club. This letter is to keep you informed of Tennis Rules and Guidelines while your children participate in the activities at the club.

The dress policy for tennis: Attire on the tennis courts shall be in good taste. For men and boys collared shirts or tennis tee shirts, above the knee sport shorts or tennis shorts. Suitable attire for the ladies and girls include collared shirts, tennis tee shirts, tennis tank tops, tennis skirts, dresses, or shorts. No halter, string strap, tube or jogbra tops are allowed. Tennis warm-ups may be worn. Flat soled sneakers only! The pro shop carries reasonably priced shorts, tennis tees and tennis sneakers.

Please be considerate of others members on the courts. Instruct children to quietly report to tennis pro shop or appropriate court for instruction. If other children are with you who are not participating, they are to be quietly supervised while watching or waiting for participants. They may not play, hit balls or be loud in the tennis area. This includes the deck, the area in front of and on the side of the tennis pro shop. There is an area behind the tennis pro shop with picnic tables where they may play quietly.

Please observe road directions and parking regulations when dropping off or picking up participants. Do not block roads or driveways even for quick pick-ups. Do not park on grass areas or in driveway near tennis pro shop. There is plenty of parking by the hard courts and we would encourage you to use that lot. There are chairs by the hard courts to view tennis lessons. After the first week of sign -up and reporting, participants may report directly to the court or instructor for their activity.

Make-ups will be held for rain outs only, on the first available day and time (that is usually a Friday or Saturday), and one time only. We can not offer make-ups for missed clinics. There is a 24 hour cancellation policy for private lessons. We will have to charge you, if you do not cancel in advance due to busy summer schedules.

Thank you for your cooperation and we look forward to a great tennis season.
